

## Mandated Health Insurance Benefits in Oklahoma

### Oklahoma Statutes, Title 36

Hi-Lited Benefits are those that would be exempted under HB 2216

- s. 6060: Mammography screening (female 35 or older)\*;
- s. 6060.1: Bone density screening (female 45 or older);
- s. 6060.2: Diabetes equipment, supplies and services;
- s. 6060.3: Post-partum maternity care;
- s. 6060.3a: Annual obstetrical/gynecological examinations
- s. 6060.4: Child immunizations;
- s. 6060.5: Inpatient care following breast cancer surgery;
- s. 6060.6: Dental anesthesia for the severely disabled or children 8 years of age and under;
- s. 6060.7: Audiological services and hearing aids for children 13 years of age and under;
- s. 6060.8: Prostate cancer screening (men 40 or older)
- s. 6060.8a: Colorectal cancer screening (age 50 or older or at high risk for colorectal cancer);
- s. 6060.9: Wigs and other scalp prosthesis related to the chemotherapy and radiation treatment;
- s. 6060.10-11: Treatment of severe mental illness\*\*

\* the mandate would not apply for women aged 35-40

\*\*uncertain if treatment of severe mental illness would have to be covered under federal mental health parity legislation

(
