

What to know about Online Voter Registration in Oklahoma

Oklahoma's newly released online voter registration system might help you or a friend register to vote. Here's what you need to know.

What is Online Voter Registration?

- Online voter registration allows eligible Oklahomans to safely and securely register to vote on a computer or mobile device.
- Instead of printing, filling, and mailing a physical voter registration form, Oklahomans with a driver's license or state-issued ID through Service Oklahoma can visit [the online registration portal](#) and fill in their information electronically.
- The State Election Board shares the information you provided on the online application with [Service Oklahoma](#), the department that provides driver and motor vehicle services to Oklahomans, to make sure the information matches up and to obtain a copy of your signature. If the information matches, you become registered to vote in Oklahoma.

Am I eligible?

- You are eligible to register to vote **online** if you:
 - Have a valid Oklahoma driver's license or state-issued identification card issued by Service Oklahoma
 - Have an electronic or digital signature on file with Service Oklahoma
 - Are eligible to vote in Oklahoma
- You are eligible to register to vote if you:
 - Are over 18
 - A Citizen of the United States
 - An Oklahoma Resident
 - Not currently serving a felony sentence

Why would I register to vote online?

- Registering to vote online can be more convenient than registering using a physical form or waiting until you update your driver's license or state-issued ID.
- The State Election Board has ensured the platform is safe and secure, meaning your important information is protected.
- Registering to vote can be done in a matter of minutes, all on your phone or a desktop computer.
- Oklahoma now joins 42 other states that have an online voter registration option, meaning the process is tried and trusted by millions of voters nationwide.



What if I don't have a driver's license or state ID?

- If you don't have a state-issued ID, you can still register to vote! However, at this time, you cannot register online.
- You can still print, sign, and mail a [physical registration form](#). The [Oklahoma voter registration form](#) can help you automate filling in your information. You will still need to print, sign, and mail this form to your county election board.

Oklahoma's new online voter registration tool is a great first step. However, there are still improvements to be made.

- Contact your lawmakers and ask them to help expand this important and useful tool to **all** eligible voters by changing state law to allow Oklahomans without a driver's license or state ID to register to vote online with their Social Security Number.
- Allowing all eligible Oklahoma voters to conveniently and securely register to vote online will help make Oklahoma a better democracy.
