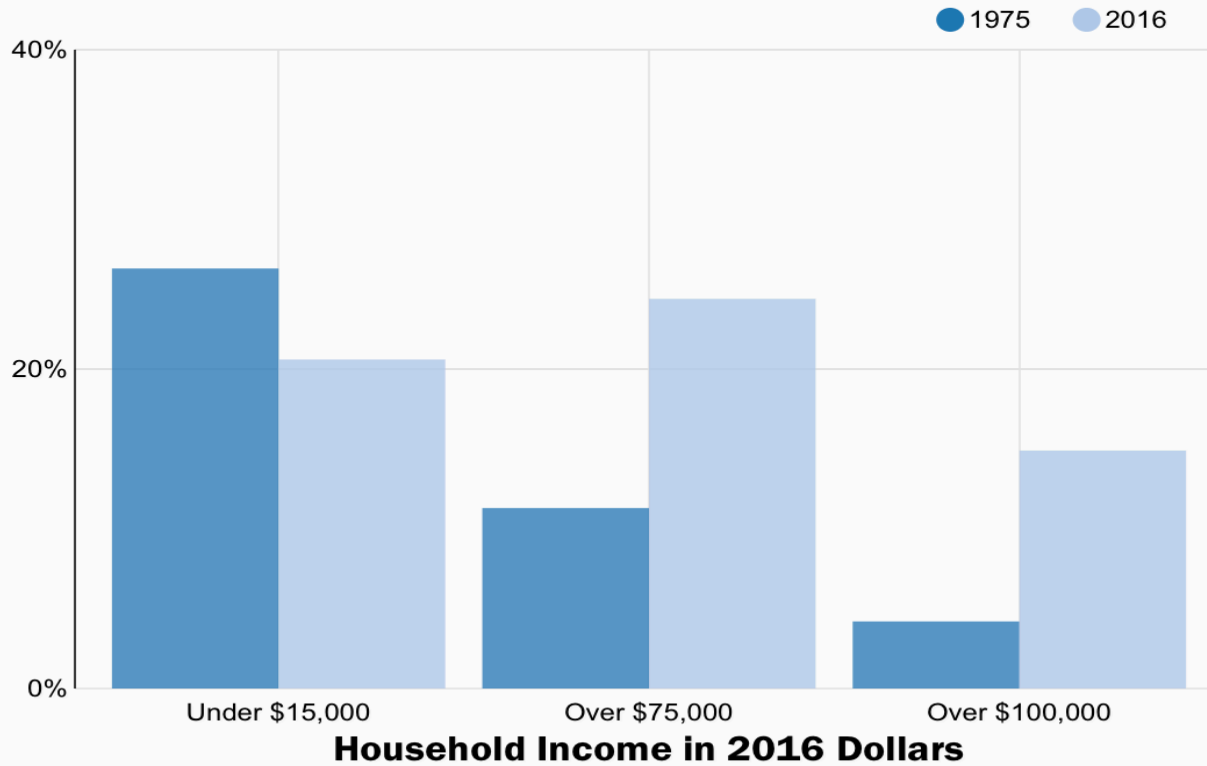

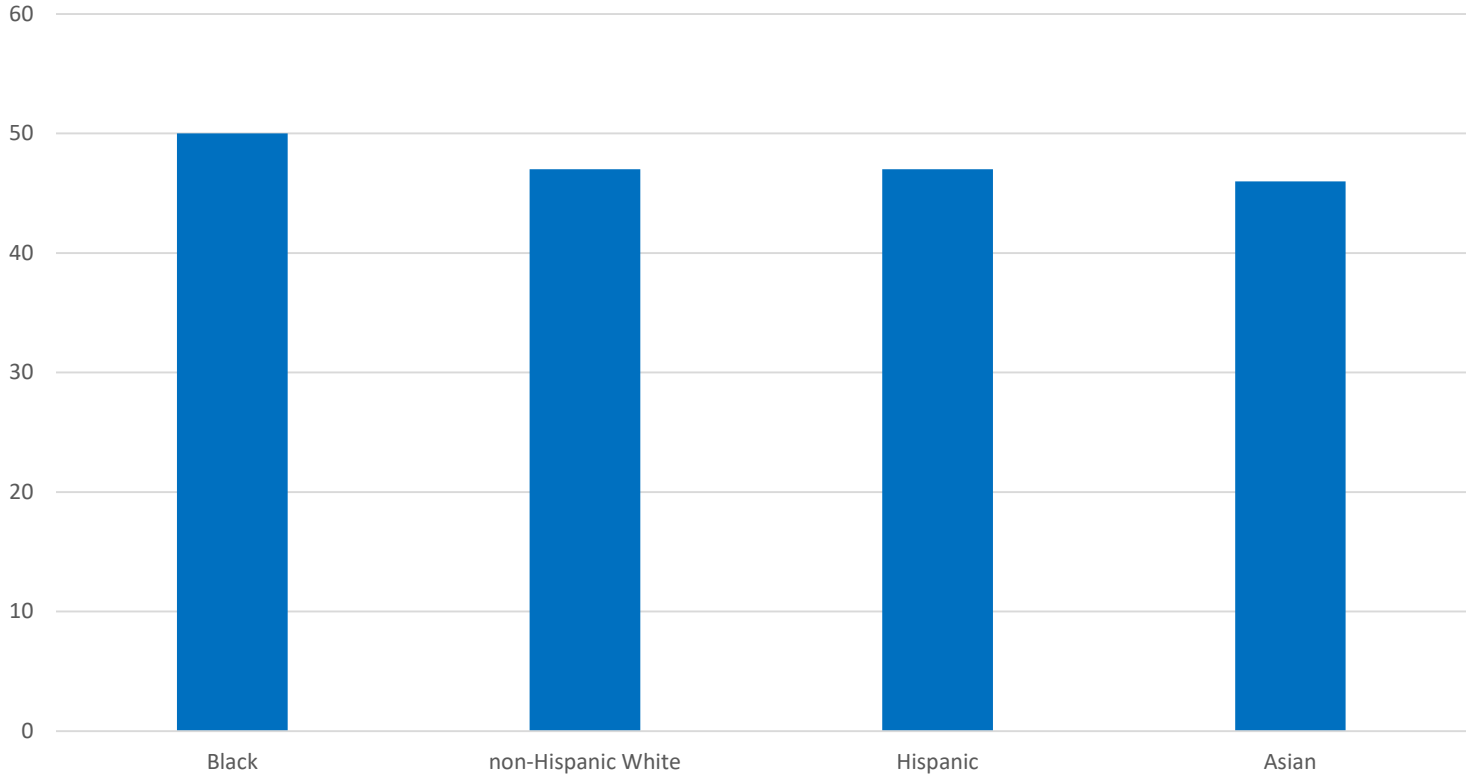
Figure 1: Share of Black Households by Income in 1975 and 2016

**Share of black households by income in 1975 and 2016**



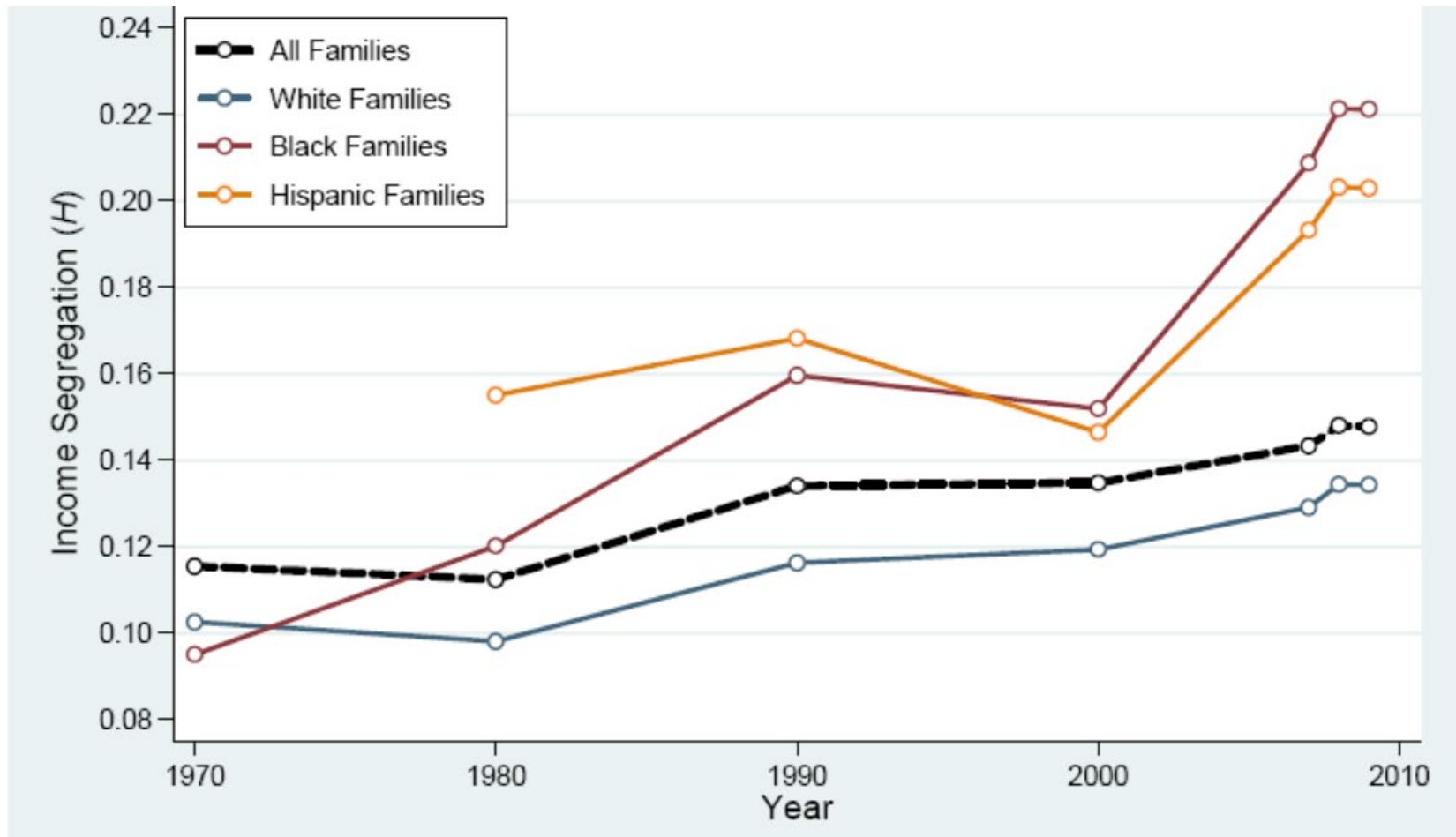

Figure 2: Gini Indexes for Households, by Race and Hispanic Origin of Householder 2016



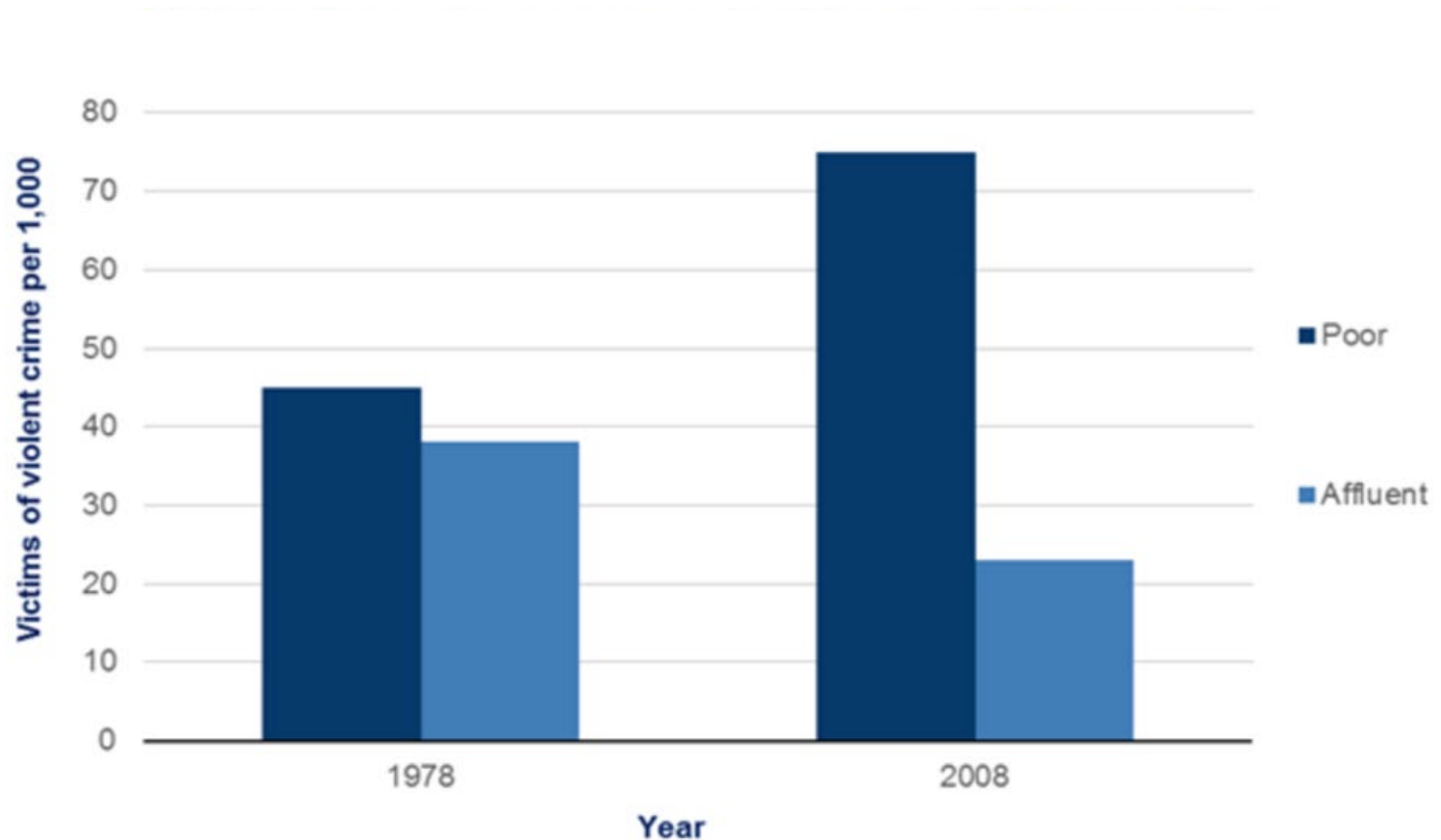
